AUDITION INFO SHEET

Thanks for your interest in wanting your child to audition for KPIK's production of Winter Wonderland. We are excited to be able to bring this unique play to the stage in Kemptonville. Hopefully this will answer some of your questions. Winter Wonderland is the story of hope, belief, snow days, kids being kids and all sorts of fun adventures in the town of Sleepy Hollow. Characters include a teacher, students, secret service agents, Frosty, Olaf, Elsa, Anna, Beanie Boos, Hansel, Gretel, Red Riding Hood, Big Bad Wolf and more!

We are still working on finalizing where auditions will be held but they will be in Kemptonville on the following days:

Thursday November 23rd (7-9pm)
Friday November 24th (PA day 12-2)
Saturday November 25th (10am-12)
Monday November 27th (7-9 pm)
Wednesday, November 29th – (5-7pm)
Thursday, November 30th (6-9pm)

Please let us know what works best for your schedule and we will confirm a time with you.

We are very supportive of all who wish to be involved in this production. Everyone who auditions will get a role in this play. Our goal for this production is to give everyone a chance to be on stage, develop their acting skills, have fun and entertain our community.

There are 24 characters in the play but some roles are smaller ones. Therefore, some actors might be asked to play a couple of parts but the script can also be amended. The auditions are meant to match characters with your child's talent and ability at this time. Also, your child's availability will be considered in casting as we will be rehearsing by scenes. We recognize our talented actors also have other commitments and we will cast people who are available to practice together. In the week leading up to production, be prepared for extra rehearsals.

We would also like to showcase any other talent your child has that they would like to share. For example, the last time this production was done, we showcased dance and gymnastics talent when the storm came in for the snowday and a keyboard talent for a song at bedtime.

Your child should come to the audition and be themselves. It gives the casting committee a good idea of who they are. What to expect from the audition:

- Each audition should be about 15 minutes
- Come prepared with a short monologue or story to tell
- The casting committee will ask some questions
- For a main role, there may be a cold read of a scene and the casting committee may give some directions
- If you would like to share another talent, be prepared to show a sample. If you need accompanying music, please come prepared

There is a \$25 annual membership fee for Kemptonville Players Kids (KPIK) to cover the cost of insurance and rehearsal times. Other than that, there should be no cost. It is hoped that the ticket sales will cover the cost of modest costumes and set design as well as the larger cost of the venue rental.

Please fill out the accompanying information sheet and bring it to the rehearsal.

Final casting should be announced December 1st and we will all get together for a full read through shortly after that.
